Our mission as the Sky Valley Arts Council is to make the Sky Valley stronger economically through a vibrant arts and heritage community. THE PROGRAM

Beauty of Bronze is a proven program with 11 years of experience in the Wenatchee School District, teaching fifth graders about the art in their community and what it means to be an artist. This impactful program gives students the opportunity to sketch and reflect on the art in their community, to work collaboratively to create a large sculpture out of natural materials and to work directly with a real artist. Students, teachers and parent volunteers spend the day with bronze artist Kevin Pettelle as their mentor. Each student creates a sculpture out of a small ingot of wax that is cast in bronze and each piece of student art is curated at the local museum. A final reception brings full circle the learnings and memories of the Beauty of Bronze experience, and students get to take their sculptures home.
